- If a scholarship finalist, participate in a personal interview with CSforA board members
- If awarded, reside at the November conference site and attend specified Climate Activist Training sessions (and others)

To apply, by October 1, 2021, submit (1) a letter of interest detailing your climate concerns, related activities and future commitments, (2) a letter of reference from an educator attesting to your character, scholarship, and seriousness of purpose, and (3) a resume including home address, email address, phone number, and date of birth.
