Climate Solutions for Alabama invites applications for Educator Mini-Grants of up to \$250 to support student learning about rapid, human-caused global warming and climate change. Grants can support grades 7-12 classroom activities and materials, independent student projects, teacher-student-community collaboration, and/or other initiatives approved by the CSforA board of directors.

We welcome proposals at any time. To apply, please submit a letter of interest including the following:

- A statement of proposed goal(s) and outcome(s)
- A description in appropriate detail of project focus/content, process, timeline (through end date), and specific expenses needing grant support
- Initiatives may address climate change causes, impacts, mitigation and/or adaptation—but MUST include student attention to climate solutions at one or more levels (e.g., individual, community, business, institutional, government)
- . Identification of other resources, if any, to be applied to the project
- Letters of support from proposed partners or collaborators, if any
- Commitment to provide an outcomes report (including student feedback)
  within one month of project completion
- Signatures of teacher applicant and school principal
